What is the new joint transport plan?

Known officially as the Local Transport Plan (LTP) 4, this will set out the long-term vision for improving transport and travel across the whole of Dorset over the next 10-15 years. The LTP is a joint initiative for Dorset Council and BCP Council. All councils are legally required to have an LTP, and this plan will replace the existing plan that expires in 2026.

What are we doing?

We're inviting you to share your views, via a survey and at our roadshow events, on what you consider to be the big transport opportunities and issues across the whole of Dorset.

Why your views are important

Your feedback will help us develop a new plan, which will incorporate all we need for a more efficient and sustainable transport network.

It will help us understand the different transport and travel needs of Dorset's varied communities, what needs improving and the travel initiatives that will benefit everyone.
