

OVERNIGHT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A30 GREENHILL, SHERBORNE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A30 Greenhill, Sherborne between Bristol Road and George Street (in both directions), a distance of approximately 10 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation at 20:00 on 4 March 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 06:00 on 5 March 2024.


This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access tto carry out camera surveys of their sewer assets.
