

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A357, STALBRIDGE

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A357, Stalbridge from junction with Waterloo Lane to Spire Hill Business Park (in both directions), a distance of approximately 890 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:00 until 16:00 on 19th February 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport if necessary; however, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26th February 2024.

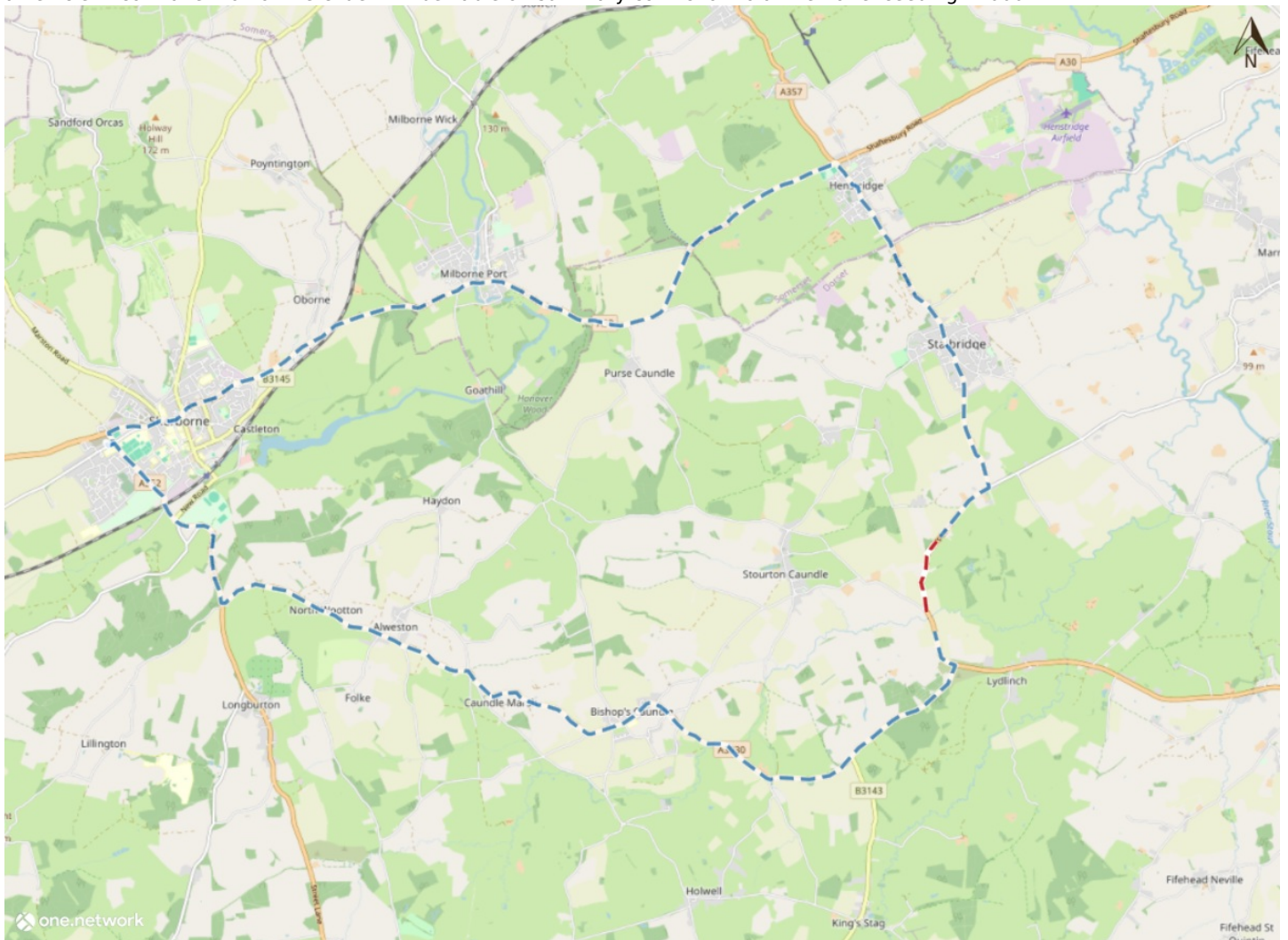
**This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.**
