

## EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF UNNAMED ROAD, PURSE CAUNDLE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Unnamed Road, Purse Caundle from junction with Well Lane to a point 100 metres to the east (in both directions). The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It came in to operation on 10th March 2025 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13th March 2025.

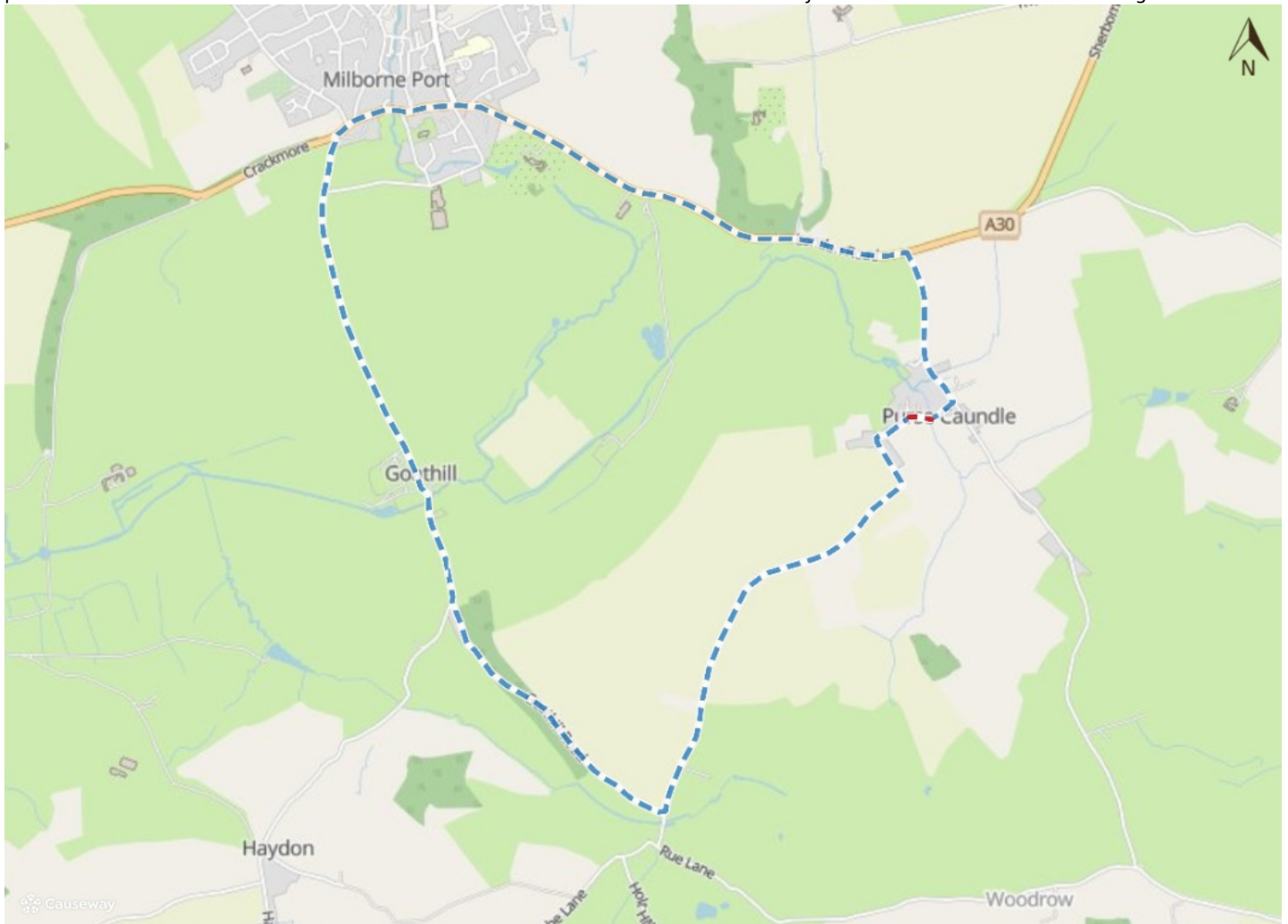
**This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out emergency works to repair a mains leak.**
